A BILL

To terminate the Economic Development Administration, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “EDA Elimination Act
5 of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AD-**
2 **MINISTRATION.**

3 (a) TERMINATION.—The Economic Development Ad-
4 ministration is terminated.

5 (b) REPEAL.—The Public Works and Economic De-
6 velopment Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3121 et seq.) is re-
7 pealed.

8 (c) CONCLUSION OF BUSINESS.—The Secretary of
9 Commerce shall take such actions as may be necessary
10 and appropriate to conclude the outstanding affairs of the
11 Economic Development Administration, including disposi-
12 tions of personnel, assets, and obligations.

13 (d) LIMITATION ON STATUTORY CONSTRUCTION.—
14 This section may not be construed to prevent the expendi-
15 ture of any funds received before the effective date of this
16 Act. Such funds shall be subject to the laws and regula-
17 tions that would have applied to the funds if this section
18 had not been enacted.

19 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

20 This Act shall take effect on the first day of the first
21 fiscal year beginning after the date of enactment of this
22 Act.

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
