Ms. ESTY submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 1565) to protect Second Amendment rights, ensure that all individuals who should be prohibited from buying a firearm are listed in the National Instant Criminal Background Check System, and provide a responsible and consistent background check process.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution the Speaker shall, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1565) to protect Second Amend-
6 ment rights, ensure that all individuals who should be pro-

1 hibited from buying a firearm are listed in the National
2 Instant Criminal Background Check System, and provide
3 a responsible and consistent background check process.
4 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All
5 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.
6 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not
7 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair
8 and ranking minority member of the Committee on the
9 Judiciary. After general debate the bill shall be considered
10 for amendment under the five-minute rule. All points of
11 order against provisions in the bill are waived. At the con-
12 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
13 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
14 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
15 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
16 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
17 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
18 structions. If the Committee of the Whole rises and re-
19 ports that it has come to no resolution on the bill, then
20 on the next legislative day the House shall, immediately
21 after the third daily order of business under clause 1 of
22 rule XIV, resolve into the Committee of the Whole for fur-
23 ther consideration of the bill.

1 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to
2 the consideration of H.R. 1565.
