Mr. JONES (for himself, Ms. BONAMICI, and Mr. GARAMENDI) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to observe a moment of silence in the House on the first legislative day of each month for those killed or wounded in the United States engagement in Afghanistan.

1 *Resolved*, That rule XIV of the Rules of the House
2 of Representatives is amended by adding at the end the
3 following new clause:

4 “7. (a) On the first legislative day of each month on
5 which there is a record vote on any bill or joint resolution,
6 immediately after that vote, a moment of silence shall be
7 observed on behalf of those killed or wounded (as well as

1 their families) in the current United States engagement
2 in Afghanistan.

3 “(b) The moment of silence shall be led by the Speak-
4 er of the House, except when granted a leave of absence
5 from the House.”.
