RESOLUTION

Recognizing the importance of nonprofit organizations and expressing support for designation of May 16, 2014, as “National Nonprofit Day”.

Whereas an estimated 2,300,000 nonprofit organizations operate in the United States;

Whereas the nonprofit sector continues to grow in size and scope;

Whereas nonprofit organizations serve a vital role in facilitating charitable giving and social action;

Whereas the combined donations and volunteer hours of individuals to nonprofit organizations are worth billions of dollars; and

Whereas May 16, 2014, would be an appropriate date to designate as “National Nonprofit Day”: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—

4 they support, and the economy of the United States;

6 (2) supports the designation of “National Non-
