RESOLUTION

- 1 *Resolved*, That rule XXI of the Rules of the House
- 2 of Representatives is amended by adding at the end the
- 3 following new clause:

1 **“Limitation on foreign assistance for more than one**
2 **country**

3 “12. It shall not be in order to consider any bill or
4 joint resolution that appropriates foreign assistance for
5 more than one country.”.
