4 **PROTECTED COMMUNICATIONS REGARDING**
5 **SEXUAL ASSAULT.**

6 Section 1034(c)(2)(A) of title 10, United States
7 Code, is amended by striking “sexual harassment or” and
8 inserting “rape, sexual assault, or other sexual misconduct
9 under sections 920 through 920c of this title (articles 120
10 through 120c of the Uniform Code of Military Justice),
11 sexual harassment, or”.

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
