A BILL

To amend the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 to repeal a provision prohibiting Federal agencies from procuring alternative fuels.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “North American Alter-
5 native Fuels Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF PROHIBITION OF THE PROCUREMENT**
2 **AND ACQUISITION OF ALTERNATIVE FUELS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 526 of the Energy Inde-
4 pendence and Security Act of 2007 (Public Law 110–140;
5 42 U.S.C. 17142) is repealed.

6 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 30310 of
7 title 51, United States Code, is repealed.
