# S. 1438

To amend the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 to provide that military technicians (dual status) shall be included in military personnel accounts for purposes of any order issued under that Act.

Mr. PRYOR (for himself, Ms. COLLINS, and Mr. BOOZMAN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Budget

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## A BILL

To amend the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 to provide that military technicians (dual status) shall be included in military personnel accounts for purposes of any order issued under that Act.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF MILITARY TECHNICIANS (DUAL**  
4       **STATUS).**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 251(a)(3) of the Balanced  
6       Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2  
7       U.S.C. 901(a)(3)) is amended by adding at the end the

1 following new sentence: “For purposes of this paragraph,  
2 military technicians (dual status) shall be included in mili-  
3 tary personnel accounts.”.

4 (b) APPLICATION OF AMENDMENT.—The amendment  
5 made by subsection (a) shall apply to any order of the  
6 President to exempt military personnel accounts from se-  
7 questration issued under section 255(f)(1) of the Balanced  
8 Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2  
9 U.S.C. 905(f)(1)) after January 1, 2014.

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
