To delay the application of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

Mr. FLAKE (for himself, Ms. AYOTTE, Mr. SCOTT, Mr. McCONNELL, Mr. BURR, Mr. CHAMBLISS, and Mr. COBURN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

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## A BILL

To delay the application of the Patient Protection and  
Affordable Care Act.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DELAY IN APPLICATION OF PATIENT PROTEC-**  
4       **TION AND AFFORDABLE CARE ACT.**

5               (1) ONE-YEAR DELAY IN PPACA PROVISIONS  
6       SCHEDULED TO TAKE EFFECT ON OR AFTER JANU-  
7       ARY 1, 2014.—Notwithstanding any other provision  
8       of law, any provision of (including any amendment  
9       made by) the Patient Protection and Affordable  
10      Care Act (Public Law 111–148) or of title I or sub-

1 title B of title II of the Health Care and Education  
2 Reconciliation Act of 2011 (Public Law 111–152)  
3 that is otherwise scheduled to take effect on or after  
4 January 1, 2014, shall not take effect until the date  
5 that is one year after the date on which such provi-  
6 sion would otherwise have been scheduled to take ef-  
7 fect.

8 (2) ONE-YEAR SUSPENSION OF CERTAIN TAX  
9 INCREASES ALREADY IN EFFECT.—Notwithstanding  
10 any other provision of law, in the case of any tax  
11 which is imposed or increased by any provision of  
12 (including any amendment made by) the Patient  
13 Protection and Affordable Care Act (Public Law  
14 111–148) or of title I or subtitle B of title II of the  
15 Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of  
16 2011 (Public Law 111–152), if such tax or increase  
17 takes effect before January 1, 2014, such tax or in-  
18 crease shall not apply during the 1-year period be-  
19 ginning on such date.

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
