A BILL

To amend the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 to extend the period during which supplemental nutrition assistance program benefits are temporarily increased.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Extend Not Cut SNAP
5 Benefits Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY INCREASE IN SUPPLE-**
 2 **MENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE BENEFITS.**

3 Section 101(a) of title I of division A of the American
 4 Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111–
 5 5; 123 Stat. 120; 124 Stat. 3265) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “section 3(o)”
 7 and inserting “section 3(u)”; and

8 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “2013” and
 9 inserting “2014”.

10 **SEC. 3. BUDGETARY EFFECTS.**

11 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
 12 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
 13 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
 14 titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation” for this
 15 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
 16 by the Chairman of the Senate Budget Committee, pro-
 17 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
 18 vote on passage.

19 **SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

20 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall
 21 take effect on September 30, 2013.

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
