A BILL

To require the Secretary of State to offer rewards of up to \$5,000,000 for information regarding the attacks on the United States diplomatic mission at Benghazi, Libya that began on September 11, 2012.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REWARDS AUTHORIZED.**

4 In accordance with the Rewards for Justice program
5 authorized under section 36(b) of the State Department

1 Basic Authorities Act of 1956 (22 U.S.C. 2708(b)), the
2 Secretary of State shall offer a reward of not more than
3 \$5,000,000 to individuals who furnish information—

4 (1) regarding the attacks on the United States
5 diplomatic mission at Benghazi, Libya that began on
6 September 11, 2012; or

7 (2) leading to the capture of an individual who
8 committed, conspired to commit, attempted to com-
9 mit, or aided in the commission of the attacks de-
10 scribed in paragraph (1).

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
