Mr. MANCHIN (for himself, Mr. SCHUMER, and Mr. KIRK) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Budget

A BILL

To amend the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 to require
a jobs score for each spending bill considered in Congress.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Jobs Score Act of
5 2013”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO THE CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET**
7 **ACT OF 1974.**

8 Section 402 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974
9 (2 U.S.C. 653) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “and” at the
2 end;

3 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking the period at
4 the end and inserting “; and”; and

5 (3) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-
6 lowing:

7 “(4) an estimate of the number of jobs which
8 would be created, sustained, or lost in carrying out
9 such bill or resolution in the fiscal year in which it
10 is to become effective and in each of the 4 fiscal
11 years following such fiscal year, together with the
12 basis for each such estimate.”.
