A BILL

To mitigate the reduction in the readiness of our Armed Forces by reducing the defense sequestration cuts for fiscal years 2014 and 2015 but implementing the cuts, in their entirety, over the duration of sequestration.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FROM SEQUESTRATION FOR FIS-**

4 **CAL YEAR 2014.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 251A(5) of the Balanced

6 Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2

7 U.S.C. 901a(5)) is amended—

1 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (A) and
2 (B) as subparagraphs (B) and (C), respectively;

3 (2) by inserting before subparagraph (B), as re-
4 designated, the following:

5 “(A) MODIFICATION OF DEFENSE FUNC-
6 TION REDUCTIONS.—Notwithstanding any other
7 provision of this Act, for discretionary appro-
8 priations and direct spending accounts within
9 function 050 (defense function)—

10 “(i) for fiscal year 2014, OMB—

11 “(I) shall not implement a reduc-
12 tion to such discretionary appropria-
13 tions and direct spending accounts in
14 the amount allocated under paragraph
15 (4); and

16 “(II) shall reduce such discre-
17 tionary appropriations and direct
18 spending by a total amount of
19 \$15,000,000,000;

20 “(ii) for fiscal year 2015, OMB—

21 “(I) shall not implement a reduc-
22 tion to such discretionary appropria-
23 tions and direct spending accounts in
24 the amount allocated under paragraph
25 (4); and

1 “(II) shall reduce such discretionary appropriations and direct spending by a total amount of
2 \$30,000,000,000;

5 “(iii) for fiscal year 2016, OMB shall increase the otherwise applicable amount of the reduction to such discretionary appropriations and direct spending accounts by \$2,000,000,000;

10 “(iv) for fiscal year 2017, OMB shall increase the otherwise applicable amount of the reduction to such discretionary appropriations and direct spending accounts by \$9,000,000,000;

15 “(v) for fiscal year 2018, OMB shall increase the otherwise applicable amount of the reduction to such discretionary appropriations and direct spending accounts by \$9,000,000,000;

20 “(vi) for fiscal year 2019, OMB shall increase the otherwise applicable amount of the reduction to such discretionary appropriations and direct spending accounts by \$12,000,000,000;

1 “(vii) for fiscal year 2020, OMB shall
2 increase the otherwise applicable amount
3 of the reduction to such discretionary ap-
4 propriations and direct spending accounts
5 by \$15,000,000,000;

6 “(viii) for fiscal year 2021, OMB shall
7 increase the otherwise applicable amount
8 of the reduction to such discretionary ap-
9 propriations and direct spending accounts
10 by \$17,400,000,000; and

11 “(ix) for each of fiscal years 2014
12 through 2021, OMB shall calculate the
13 amount of the respective reductions to dis-
14 cretionary appropriations and direct spend-
15 ing (as adjusted under this subparagraph)
16 in accordance with subparagraphs (B) and
17 (C).”;

18 (3) in subparagraph (B)(i), as redesignated, by
19 inserting “as adjusted, if adjusted, in accordance
20 with subparagraph (A)” after “paragraph (4)”; and

21 (4) in subparagraph (C), as redesignated—

22 (A) by inserting “as adjusted, if adjusted,
23 in accordance with subparagraph (A)” after
24 “paragraph (4)”; and

(B) by striking “ subparagraph (A)” and inserting “ subparagraph (B)”.
