A BILL

To provide for the conversion of temporary judgeships for the districts of Hawaii and Kansas to permanent judgeships.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVERSION OF TEMPORARY JUDGESHIPS TO**
4 **PERMANENT JUDGESHIPS FOR THE DIS-**
5 **TRICTS OF HAWAII AND KANSAS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The existing judgeship for the dis-
7 trict of Hawaii and the existing judgeship for the district
8 of Kansas authorized by section 203(c) of the Judicial Im-
9 provements Act of 1990 (28 U.S.C. 133 note; Public Law
10 101–650; 104 Stat. 5089) shall, as of the date of enact-

1 ment of this Act, be authorized under section 133 of title
 2 28, United States Code, and the incumbent in each such
 3 office shall hold the office under section 133 of title 28,
 4 United States Code, as amended by this Act.

5 (b) TABLES.—In order that the table contained in
 6 section 133(a) of title 28, United States Code, will reflect
 7 the change in the total number of permanent district
 8 judgeships authorized as a result of subsection (a) of this
 9 section—

10 (1) the item relating to Hawaii is amended to
 11 read as follows:

“Hawaii 4”;

12 and

13 (2) the item relating to Kansas is amended to
 14 read as follows:

“Kansas 6”.
