A BILL

To repeal the Authorization for Use of Military Force
Against Iraq Resolution of 2002.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF AUTHORIZATION FOR USE OF MILI-**
4 **TARY FORCE AGAINST IRAQ.**

5 (a) REPEAL.—The Authorization for Use of Military
6 Force Against Iraq Resolution of 2002 (Public Law 107–
7 243; 116 Stat. 1498; 50 U.S.C. 1541 note) is hereby re-
8 pealed.

1 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sec-
2 tion shall be construed as limiting or prohibiting any au-
3 thority of the President to—

4 (1) provide security for United States facilities,
5 military assets, or military or diplomatic personnel
6 located in Iraq; or

7 (2) gather, provide, and share intelligence with
8 the Government of Iraq if the President determines
9 it to be in the national security interests of the
10 United States.

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
