A BILL

To enhance penalties for computer crimes, and for other
purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Credit Card Theft Sen-
5 tencing Act of 2014”.

6 **SEC. 2. ENHANCED PENALTY.**

7 Section 1030 of title 18, United States Code, is
8 amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a)(2)(A), by striking “in sec-
10 tion 1602(n) of title 15” and inserting “in section

1 103(o) of the Consumer Credit Protection Act (15
2 U.S.C. 1602(o))”; and

3 (2) in subsection (c)(2)—

4 (A) in subparagraph (B)(iii), by striking
5 “and” at the end;

6 (B) in subparagraph (C), by inserting
7 “and” after the semicolon; and

8 (C) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(D) a fine under this title, imprisonment for
10 any term of years not less than 25 or for life, or
11 both, in the case of an offense under subsection
12 (a)(2) in which information of 1,000,000 or more
13 cardholders (as defined in section 103(n) of the Con-
14 sumer Credit Protection Act (15 U.S.C. 1602(n))) is
15 obtained;”.

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
