A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to remove the 96-hour physician certification requirement for inpatient critical access hospital services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Critical Access Hos-
5 pital Relief Act of 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. REMOVING MEDICARE 96-HOUR PHYSICIAN CER-**
2 **TIFICATION REQUIREMENT FOR INPATIENT**
3 **CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITAL SERVICES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1814(a) of the Social Se-
5 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395f(a)) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (6), by adding “and” at the
7 end;

8 (2) in paragraph (7), at the end of subpara-
9 graph (D)(ii), by striking “and” and inserting a pe-
10 riod; and

11 (3) by striking paragraph (8).

12 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendments made by sub-
13 section (a) shall apply with respect to items and services
14 furnished on or after January 1, 2014.

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
