AN ACT

To repeal certain requirements regarding newspaper
advertising of Senate stationery contracts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SENATE STATIONERY PROCEDURES.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Sections 65, 66, 67, and 68 of
3 the Revised Statutes (2 U.S.C. 6569, 6570, 6571) are re-
4 pealed.

5 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The fifth para-
6 graph after the paragraph under the side heading “FOR
7 CONTINGENT EXPENSES, NAMELY:” under the subheading
8 “SENATE.” under the heading “LEGISLATIVE.” of the
9 Act of March 3, 1887 (24 Stat. 596, chapter 392; 2
10 U.S.C. 6572), is amended by striking “sections, sixty-five,
11 sixty six, sixty-seven, sixty-eight, and sixty-nine,” and in-
12 serting “section 69”.
