Mr. BEGICH introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To enhance the safety of drug-free playgrounds.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Drug-Free Play-
5 grounds Safety Enhancement Act of 2014”.

6 **SEC. 2. DRUG-FREE PLAYGROUNDS.**

7 Section 419 of the Controlled Substances Act (21
8 U.S.C. 860) is amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “video arcade
10 facility” and inserting “video amusement game facil-
11 ity”; and

12 (2) in subsection (e)—

1 (A) in paragraph (1)—

2 (i) by striking “outdoor facility” and
3 inserting “outdoor area”;

4 (ii) by striking “three or more sepa-
5 rate” and inserting “1 or more”;

6 (iii) by inserting “play structures,”
7 after “not limited to,”; and

8 (iv) by striking “and teeterboards”
9 and inserting “seesaw, merry-go-round,
10 slides, jungle gym, chin-up bars, sandbox,
11 spring rider, monkey bars, overhead lad-
12 ders, trapeze rings, playhouses, rope
13 bridges, and mazes”; and

14 (B) by amending paragraph (3) to read as
15 follows:

16 “(3) The term ‘video amusement game facility’
17 means any facility, legally accessible to persons
18 under 18 years of age, intended primarily for amuse-
19 ment, which contains video game machines or other
20 similar youth games.”.

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
