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## A BILL

To amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act  
of 1965 to allow for data collection about military-con-  
nected students.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Helping Military Chil-  
5       dren Succeed in Schools Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO THE ELEMENTARY AND SEC-**  
2 **ONDARY EDUCATION ACT.**

3 Section 1111(h)(1)(C) of the Elementary and Sec-  
4 ondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6311(h)(1)(C))  
5 is amended—

6 (1) in clause (vii) by striking “and” after the  
7 semicolon;

8 (2) in clause (viii) by striking the period at the  
9 end and inserting “; and”; and

10 (3) by inserting after clause (viii) the following:

11 “(ix) information regarding the num-  
12 ber of military-connected students which,  
13 for the purposes of this clause, shall mean  
14 students with a parent who serves in the  
15 Armed Forces, including the National  
16 Guard and Reserve Forces, and informa-  
17 tion regarding academic achievement for  
18 such students, except that such informa-  
19 tion shall not be used for school or local  
20 educational agency accountability purposes  
21 under section 1116.”.

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
