Ms. HIRONO introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to expand the role of the Chief of the National Guard Bureau in the assignment of Directors and Deputy Directors of the Army National Guard and Air National Guard.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ROLE OF THE CHIEF OF THE NATIONAL GUARD**
4 **BUREAU IN ASSIGNMENT OF DIRECTORS AND**
5 **DEPUTY DIRECTORS OF THE ARMY NA-**
6 **TIONAL GUARD AND AIR NATIONAL GUARD.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 10506(a) of title 10,
8 United States Code, is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1)—

2 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “se-
3 lected by the Secretary of the Army” and in-
4 serting “recommended by the Chief of the Na-
5 tional Guard Bureau, from not less than three
6 candidates identified by the Secretary of the
7 Army,”; and

8 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking “se-
9 lected by the Secretary of the Air Force” and
10 inserting “recommended by the Chief of the
11 National Guard Bureau, from not less than
12 three candidates identified by the Secretary of
13 the Air Force,”; and

14 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “The officers
15 so selected” and inserting “The Director and Dep-
16 uty Director, Army National Guard, and the Direc-
17 tor and Deputy Director, Air National Guard,”.

18 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS REGARDING AP-
19 POINTMENT.—Paragraph (3) of such section is amend-
20 ed—

21 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “The
22 President” and inserting “Consistent with para-
23 graph (1), the President”;

24 (2) by striking subparagraphs (B) and (D); and

- 1 (3) by redesignating subparagraphs (C) and (E)
- 2 as subparagraphs (B) and (C), respectively.

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
