Mr. JOHNSON of Wisconsin introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Budget

A BILL

To require the Congressional Budget Office to annually report changes in direct spending and revenue associated with the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Truth in Obamacare
5 Accounting Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET OFFICE REPORTING ON**
2 **THE PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORD-**
3 **ABLE CARE ACT.**

4 The Congressional Budget Office shall include in
5 each annual report on the budget and economic outlook,
6 and each revision of such a report, prepared under section
7 202(e) of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C.
8 602(e)), information on the net effect that the enactment
9 and implementation of the Patient Protection and Afford-
10 able Care Act (Public Law 111–148) and the Health Care
11 and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public Law
12 111–152) had on direct spending and revenue, including
13 the net impact that such enactment and implementation
14 had on deficit, both on-budget and off-budget. Such infor-
15 mation shall be disclosed in a manner similar to that pro-
16 vided for in table 2 of the Congressional Budget Office’s
17 March 20, 2010, estimate of the budgetary effects of the
18 Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010
19 and the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

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
