A BILL

To designate the James L. Oberstar Memorial Highway and the James L. Oberstar National Scenic Byway in the State of Minnesota.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. JAMES L. OBERSTAR MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The segment of Interstate Route
5 35 between milepost 133 at Forest Lake, Minnesota, and
6 milepost 259 at Duluth, Minnesota, shall be known and
7 designated as the “James L. Oberstar Memorial High-
8 way”.

9 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
10 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the segment of Interstate Route 35 referred to
2 in subsection (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to the
3 “James L. Oberstar Memorial Highway”.

4 **SEC. 2. JAMES L. OBERSTAR NATIONAL SCENIC BYWAY.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The segment of United States
6 Route 61 between milepost 0 at Duluth, Minnesota, and
7 milepost 150 at Grand Portage, Minnesota, shall be
8 known and designated as the “James L. Oberstar Na-
9 tional Scenic Byway”.

10 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
11 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
12 States to the segment of United States Route 61 referred
13 to in subsection (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to
14 the “James L. Oberstar National Scenic Byway”.

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
