A BILL

To clarify the authority of the United States Marshals Service to assist other Federal, State, and local law enforcement agencies in the investigation of cases involving missing children.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Strengthening Inves-
5 tigations of Missing Children Act of 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF AUTHORITY OF THE UNITED**
2 **STATES MARSHALS SERVICE.**

3 Section 566(e)(1) of title 28, United States Code, is
4 amended—

5 (1) in subparagraph (B), by striking “and” at
6 the end;

7 (2) in subparagraph (C), by striking the period
8 at the end and inserting “; and”; and

9 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (C), the fol-
10 lowing:

11 “(D) assist State, local, and other Federal
12 law enforcement agencies, upon the request of
13 such an agency, in locating and recovering
14 missing children.”.

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
