A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to direct the task force of the Office of Veterans Business Development to provide access to and manage the distribution of overseas excess or surplus property to veteran-owned small businesses.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Veterans Small Busi-
5 ness Enhancement Act of 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. ACCESS TO OVERSEAS EXCESS OR SURPLUS PROP-**
2 **ERTY FOR VETERAN-OWNED SMALL BUSI-**
3 **NESSES.**

4 Section 32(c)(3)(B) of the Small Business Act (15
5 U.S.C. 657b(c)(3)(B)) is amended—

6 (1) in clause (v), by striking “; and” and insert-
7 ing a semicolon;

8 (2) in clause (vi), by striking the period at the
9 end and inserting “; and”; and

10 (3) by adding at the end the following:

11 “(vii) providing access to and man-
12 aging the distribution of excess or surplus
13 property located outside the United States
14 that is owned by the United States to
15 small business concerns owned and con-
16 trolled by veterans, pursuant to a memo-
17 randum of understanding between the task
18 force and the head of the applicable state
19 agency (as defined in section 549 of title
20 40, United States Code).”.

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
