A BILL

To require the Inspector General of the Environmental
Protection Agency to include certain assessments in reports.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCLUSIONS IN EPA INSPECTOR GENERAL RE-**
4 **PORTS.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in the
6 reports required to be submitted by the Inspector General
7 of the Environmental Protection Agency not later than
8 April 30 and October 31 of each calendar year, the Inspec-
9 tor General shall include an assessment of whether the
10 Environmental Protection Agency achieved compliance

1 during the period covered by the report with the require-
2 ments of—

3 (1)(A) the portions of section 4 of Executive
4 Order 12866 (58 Fed. Reg. 51735 (September 30,
5 1993)) and Executive Order 13563 (76 Fed. Reg.
6 3821 (January 18, 2011)) that are applicable to the
7 uniform reporting of regulatory and deregulatory
8 agendas; and

9 (B) any successor Executive orders establishing
10 requirements applicable to the uniform reporting of
11 regulatory and deregulatory agendas;

12 (2) section 602 of title 5, United States Code;

13 (3) the portions of section 202 of the Unfunded
14 Mandates Reform Act of 1995 (2 U.S.C. 1532) that
15 require agencies to publish certain written state-
16 ments before promulgating any general notice of
17 proposed rulemaking; and

18 (4) section 8 of Executive Order 13132 (64
19 Fed. Reg. 43258 (August 4, 1999)).

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
