A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to prohibit the exclusion of individuals from service on a Federal jury on account of sexual orientation or gender identity.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Jury Access for Capa-
5 ble Citizens and Equality in Service Selection Act of
6 2013” or the “Jury ACCESS Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXCLUSION FROM FEDERAL JURIES ON ACCOUNT**
2 **OF SEXUAL ORIENTATION OR GENDER IDEN-**
3 **TITY PROHIBITED.**

4 Section 1862 of title 28, United States Code, is
5 amended by inserting “sexual orientation, gender iden-
6 tity,” after “sex,”.

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
