A BILL

To amend title 40, United States Code, to improve veterans service organizations access to Federal surplus personal property.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Formerly Owned Re-
5 sources for Veterans to Express Thanks for Service Act
6 of 2013” or the “FOR VETS Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. VETERANS ACCESS TO FEDERAL EXCESS AND SUR-**
2 **PLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY.**

3 Section 549(c)(3) of title 40, United States Code, is
4 amended—

5 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “or” at
6 the end;

7 (2) in subparagraph (B)—

8 (A) in clause (viii), by adding “or” at the
9 end; and

10 (B) by striking clause (x); and

11 (3) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(C) for purposes of providing services to
13 veterans (as defined in section 101 of title 38),
14 to an organization whose—

15 “(i) membership comprises substan-
16 tially veterans; and

17 “(ii) representatives are recognized by
18 the Secretary of Veterans Affairs under
19 section 5902 of title 38.”.
