Mr. CORNYN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To withhold the salary of the Director of OMB upon failure to submit the President's budget to Congress as required by section 1105 of title 31, United States Code.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Budget, No OMB
5 Pay Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. DETERMINATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH STATU-**
2 **TORY REQUIREMENT TO SUBMIT THE PRESI-**
3 **DENT'S BUDGET.**

4 Not later than 3 days after the President's budget
5 is due, the Inspector General of the Office of Personnel
6 Management shall—

7 (1) make an annual determination of whether
8 the Director of the Office of Management and Budg-
9 et (OMB) and the President are in compliance with
10 section 1105 of title 31, United States Code; and

11 (2) provide a written notification of such deter-
12 mination to the Chairpersons of the Committee on
13 the Budget and the Committee on Appropriations of
14 the Senate and the Chairpersons of the Committee
15 on the Budget and the Committee on Appropriations
16 of the House of Representatives.

17 **SEC. 3. NO PAY UPON FAILURE TO TIMELY SUBMIT THE**
18 **PRESIDENT'S BUDGET TO CONGRESS.**

19 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
20 sion of law, no funds may be appropriated or otherwise
21 be made available from the United States Treasury for
22 the pay of the Director of OMB, Deputy Director of OMB,
23 and the Deputy Director for Management of OMB during
24 any period of noncompliance determined by the Inspector
25 General of the Office of Personnel Management under sec-
26 tion 2.

1 (b) NO RETROACTIVE PAY.—The Director of OMB,
2 Deputy Director of OMB, and the Deputy Director for
3 Management of OMB may not receive pay for any period
4 of noncompliance determined by the Inspector General of
5 the Office of Personnel Management under section 2 at
6 any time after the end of that period.

7 **SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

8 This Act shall take effect upon the date of enactment
9 of this Act.

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
