A BILL

To amend the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 to repeal a duplicative program relating to inspection and grading of catfish.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF DUPLICATIVE PROGRAM.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Effective on the date of enact-
5 ment of the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008
6 (7 U.S.C. 8701 et seq.), section 11016 of that Act (Public
7 Law 110–246; 122 Stat. 2130) and the amendments made
8 by that section are repealed.

1 (b) APPLICATION.—The Agricultural Marketing Act
2 of 1946 (7 U.S.C. 1621 et seq.) and the Federal Meat
3 Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. 601 et seq.) shall be applied
4 and administered as if section 11016 of the Food, Con-
5 servation, and Energy Act of 2008 (Public Law 110–246;
6 122 Stat. 2130) and the amendments made by that sec-
7 tion had not been enacted.

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
