A BILL

To amend Public Law 101–377 to revise the boundaries of the Gettysburg National Military Park to include the Gettysburg Train Station, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Gettysburg National
3 Military Park Expansion Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. GETTYSBURG NATIONAL MILITARY PARK EXPAN-**
5 **SION.**

6 (a) GETTYSBURG NATIONAL MILITARY PARK
7 BOUNDARY REVISION.—Section 4 of Public Law 101–377
8 (16 U.S.C. 430g–4) is amended by adding at the end the
9 following:

10 “(d) ADDITIONAL LAND.—In addition to the land de-
11 scribed in subsections (a) and (b), the park shall include—

12 “(1) the property commonly known as the ‘Get-
13 tysburg Train Station’ (including land located in
14 close proximity to the Gettysburg Train Station)
15 that is—

16 “(A) located in the Borough of Gettysburg;
17 and

18 “(B) depicted on the map entitled ‘Gettys-
19 burg National Military Park, Proposed Bound-
20 ary’, numbered 305/80,045, and dated Sep-
21 tember 2008; and

22 “(2) the property that is—

23 “(A) located adjacent to Plum Run in
24 Cumberland Township; and

25 “(B) depicted on the map entitled ‘Gettys-
26 burg National Military Park, Proposed Bound-

1 ary Addition’, numbered 305/80,046, and dated
2 February 2009.”.

3 (b) ~~ACQUISITION AND DISPOSAL OF LAND.~~—Section
4 2(a) of Public Law 101-377 (16 U.S.C. 430g-5(a)) is
5 amended—

6 (1) by striking “The Secretary” and inserting
7 the following:

8 “(1) ~~IN GENERAL.~~—The Secretary”; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(2) ~~ACQUISITION OF PUBLICLY OWNED~~
11 ~~LAND.~~—

12 “(A) ~~IN GENERAL.~~—Subject to subpara-
13 graph (B), the Secretary may acquire only by
14 purchase from a willing seller publicly owned
15 property that is located within the property de-
16 scribed in section 1(d)(1) if the Secretary deter-
17 mines that efforts to acquire the property with-
18 out cost have been exhausted.

19 “(B) ~~EMINENT DOMAIN.~~—The Secretary
20 may not acquire by eminent domain property
21 that is located within the property described in
22 section 1(d)(1).”.

1 **SEC. 2. GETTYSBURG NATIONAL MILITARY PARK EXPAN-**
 2 **SION.**

3 (a) *BOUNDARY REVISION.*—Section 1(b) of Public Law
 4 101–377 (16 U.S.C. 430g–4(b)) is amended—

5 (1) by striking “include the” and insert “in-
 6 clude—

7 “(1) the”;

8 (2) at the end of paragraph (1) (as designated
 9 by paragraph (1)), by striking the period and insert-
 10 ing “; and”; and

11 (3) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(2) the properties depicted as ‘Proposed Addi-
 13 tion’ on the map entitled ‘Gettysburg National Mili-
 14 tary Park Proposed Boundary Addition’, numbered
 15 305/80,045, and dated January, 2010 (2 sheets), in-
 16 cluding—

17 “(A) the property commonly known as the
 18 ‘Gettysburg Train Station’; and

19 “(B) the property located adjacent to Plum
 20 Run in Cumberland Township.”.

21 (b) *ACQUISITION OF LAND.*—Section 2(a) of Public
 22 Law 101–377 (16 U.S.C. 430g–5(a)) is amended—

23 (1) in the first sentence, by striking “The
 24 Secretary” and inserting the following:

25 “(1) *AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE LAND.*—The Sec-
 26 retary”;

1 (2) *in the second sentence, by striking “In ac-*
2 *quiring” and inserting the following:*

3 “(2) *MINIMUM FEDERAL INTERESTS.—In acquir-*
4 *ing”; and*

5 (3) *by adding at the end the following:*

6 “(3) *METHODS OF ACQUISITION FOR CERTAIN*
7 *LAND.—Notwithstanding paragraph (1), the Sec-*
8 *retary may acquire the properties added to the park*
9 *by section 1(b)(2) only—*

10 “(A) *by donation; or*

11 “(B) *if the Secretary determines that efforts*
12 *to acquire the properties without cost have been*
13 *exhausted, by purchase from a willing seller.”.*

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
