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## A BILL

Preventing an unrealistic future Medicaid augmentation plan.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Preventing an Unreal-  
5       istic FMAP Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PREVENTING AN UNREALISTIC FEDERAL MEDICAL**  
 2 **ASSISTANCE PERCENTAGE BY REPEALING**  
 3 **THE AFFORDABLE CARE ACT ENHANCED**  
 4 **FEDERAL MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PERCENT-**  
 5 **AGES FOR MEDICAID EXPANSIONS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1905 of the Social Secu-  
 7 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d) is amended by striking sub-  
 8 sections (y) and (z).

9 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section 1905 of  
 10 such Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d) is amended—

11 (1) in the first sentence of subsection (b)—

12 (A) by striking “subsections (y), (z), and”  
 13 and inserting “subsection”; and

14 (B) by striking “and subsection (y) (with-  
 15 out regard to paragraph (1)(C) of such sub-  
 16 section)”;

17 (2) in subsection (aa), in each of paragraphs  
 18 (1)(A), (2)(A), and (3), by striking “, subsections  
 19 (y) and (z),” each place it appears; and

20 (3) in subsection (cc), by striking “subsections  
 21 (y), (z), and” and inserting “subsection”.

22 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
 23 this section shall take effect on the earlier of—

24 (1) the date of enactment of this Act; or

25 (2) December 31, 2013.
