# A BILL

To amend the Water Resources Research Act of 1984 to reauthorize grants for and require applied water supply research regarding the water resources research and technology institutes established under that Act.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Water Resources Re-  
3 search Amendments Act of 2013”.

4 **SEC. 2. WATER RESOURCES RESEARCH ACT AMENDMENTS.**

5 (a) CONGRESSIONAL FINDINGS AND DECLARA-  
6 TIONS.—Section 102 of the Water Resources Research  
7 Act of 1984 (42 U.S.C. 10301) is amended—

8 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (7) through  
9 (9) as paragraphs (8) through (10), respectively;

10 (2) in paragraph (8) (as so redesignated), by  
11 striking “and” at the end; and

12 (3) by inserting after paragraph (6) the fol-  
13 lowing:

14 “(7) additional research is required into in-  
15 creasing the effectiveness and efficiency of new and  
16 existing treatment works through alternative ap-  
17 proaches, including—

18 “(A) nonstructural alternatives;

19 “(B) decentralized approaches;

20 “(C) water use efficiency; and

21 “(D) actions to reduce energy consumption  
22 or extract energy from wastewater;

23 “(C) energy use efficiency;

24 “(D) water use efficiency; and

25 “(E) actions to extract energy from waste-  
26 water;.”.

1       (b) CLARIFICATION OF RESEARCH ACTIVITIES.—Sec-  
2 tion 104(b)(1) of the Water Resources Research Act of  
3 1984 (42 U.S.C. 10303(b)(1)) is amended—

4                 (1) in subparagraph (B)(ii), by striking “water-  
5 related phenomena” and inserting “water re-  
6 sources”; and

7                 (2) in subparagraph (D), by striking the period  
8 at the end and inserting “; and”.

9       (c) COMPLIANCE REPORT.—Section 104(c) of the  
10 Water Resources Research Act of 1984 (42 U.S.C.  
11 10303(c)) is amended—

12                 (1) by striking “From the” and inserting “(1)  
13 IN GENERAL.—From the”; and

14                 (2) by adding at the end the following:

15                 “(2) REPORT.—Not later than December 31 of  
16 each fiscal year, the Secretary shall submit to the  
17 Committee on Environment and Public Works of the  
18 Senate, the Committee on the Budget of the Senate,  
19 the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure  
20 of the House of Representatives, and the Committee  
21 on the Budget of the House of Representatives a re-  
22 port regarding the compliance of each funding re-  
23 cipient with this subsection for the immediately pre-  
24 ceding fiscal year.”.

1       (d) EVALUATION OF WATER RESOURCES RESEARCH  
2 PROGRAM.—Section 104 of the Water Resources Research  
3 Act of 1984 (42 U.S.C. 10303) is amended by striking  
4 subsection (e) and inserting the following:

5       “(e) EVALUATION OF WATER RESOURCES RESEARCH  
6 PROGRAM.—

7           “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall con-  
8           duct a careful and detailed evaluation of each insti-  
9           tute at least once every 3 years to determine—

10           “(A) the quality and relevance of the water  
11           resources research of the institute;

12           “(B) the effectiveness of the institute at  
13           producing measured results and applied water  
14           supply research; and

15           “(C) whether the effectiveness of the insti-  
16           tute as an institution for planning, conducting,  
17           and arranging for research warrants continued  
18           support under this section.

19           “(2) PROHIBITION ON FURTHER SUPPORT.—If,  
20           as a result of an evaluation under paragraph (1), the  
21           Secretary determines that an institute does not qual-  
22           ify for further support under this section, no further  
23           grants to the institute may be provided until the  
24           qualifications of the institute are reestablished to the  
25           satisfaction of the Secretary.”.

1       (e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section  
2 104(f)(1) of the Water Resources Research Act of 1984  
3 (42 U.S.C. 10303(f)(1)) is amended by striking  
4 “\$12,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2007 through 2011”  
5 and inserting “\$7,500,000 for each of fiscal years 2013  
6 through 2018”.

7       (f) ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS WHERE RE-  
8 SEARCH FOCUSED ON WATER PROBLEMS OF INTERSTATE  
9 NATURE.—Section 104(g)(1) of the Water Resources Re-  
10 search Act of 1984 (42 U.S.C. 10303(g)(1)) is amended  
11 by striking “\$6,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2007  
12 through 2011” and inserting “\$1,500,000 for each of fis-  
13 cal years 2013 through 2018”.
