CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress that the United States should ensure that Israel is able to adequately address an existential Iranian nuclear threat and to support Israel's right to respond to the potential threat of a Syrian S-300 air defense system.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This resolution may be cited as the “Support of Israel

5 Against Existential Threat Resolution of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS ON SUPPORT TO ISRAEL TO**
2 **ADDRESS IRANIAN AND SYRIAN THREATS.**

3 It is the sense of Congress that—

4 (1) the United States should ensure that Israel,
5 as a critical United States ally, is able to adequately
6 address an existential Iranian nuclear threat, and
7 the Secretary of Defense should seek related oppor-
8 tunities for defense cooperation and partnership on
9 military capabilities where appropriate; and

10 (2) the delivery of the S–300 air defense system
11 to Syria would pose a grave risk to Israel, and the
12 United States supports Israel’s right to respond to
13 this grave threat as needed.

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
