1 **SECTION 1. USE OF EMANCIPATION HALL FOR CEREMONY**
2 **TO COMMEMORATE 150TH ANNIVERSARY OF**
3 **RATIFICATION OF 13TH AMENDMENT.**

4 Emancipation Hall in the Capitol Visitor Center is
5 authorized to be used on December 8, 2015, for a cere-
6 mony to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the ratifi-
7 cation of the 13th Amendment to the Constitution of the
8 United States, which abolished slavery in the United
9 States. Physical preparations for the conduct of the cere-
10 mony shall be carried out in accordance with such condi-
11 tions as the Architect of the Capitol may prescribe.
