A BILL

To provide for the compensation of furloughed Department of Homeland Security employees in the event of a lapse in Department of Homeland Security appropriations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “DHS Employee Retro-
5 active Pay Fairness Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. COMPENSATION FOR FURLOUGHED FEDERAL EM-**
2 **PLOYEES DUE TO LAPSE IN DEPARTMENT OF**
3 **HOMELAND SECURITY FUNDING.**

4 Any Federal employee who is furloughed as a result
5 of any lapse in appropriations which begins on or about
6 February 27, 2015, shall be compensated at such employ-
7 ee's standard rate of compensation, for the period of such
8 lapse, as soon as practicable after such lapse in appropria-
9 tions ends.

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
