A BILL

To amend the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 to modify
the exception to the work requirement.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “SNAP Work Opportu-
5 nities Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

7 (a) WORK REQUIREMENT.—Section 6(o)(3) of the
8 Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2015(o)(3))
9 is amended—

1 (1) in subparagraph (D) by striking “or” at the
2 end,

3 (2) in subparagraph (E) by striking the period
4 at the end and inserting “; or”, and

5 (3) by adding at end the following:

6 “(F) not offered a position in a program
7 described in subparagraph (B) or (C) of para-
8 graph (2).”.

9 (b) FUNDING OF EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING PRO-
10 GRAMS.—Section 16(h)(1)(E)(ii)(II) of the Food and Nu-
11 trition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2025(h)(1)(E)(ii)(II)) is
12 amended by inserting “subparagraphs (A) through (E) of”
13 after “under”.

14 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

15 This Act, and the amendments made by this Act,
16 shall take effect on the 1st day of the 1st fiscal year that
17 begins after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
