A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to eliminate tariffs on technological goods providing educational value for children, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Elimination of Tariffs
5 on Education for Children’s Act” or the “ETEACH Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF TARIFFS ON CERTAIN EDU-**
 2 **CATIONAL DEVICES.**

3 Chapter 85 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
 4 United States is amended by inserting in numerical se-
 5 quence the following new subheading, with the article de-
 6 scription for subheading 8543.70.94 having the same de-
 7 gree of indentation as the article description for sub-
 8 heading 8543.70.93:

“	8543.70.94	Electronic educational devices de- signed or intended primarily for children	Free		35%	”.
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9 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

10 The amendment made by section 2 applies to goods
 11 entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption,
 12 on or after the 15th day after the date of the enactment
 13 of this Act.

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
