Mr. FITZPATRICK introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to increase from 1 to 2 years the post employment restrictions on Members of the House of Representatives.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASE IN POST EMPLOYMENT RESTRIC-**
4 **TIONS FOR MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF**
5 **REPRESENTATIVES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 207(e)(1) of title 18,
7 United States Code, is amended—

8 (1) in subparagraph (A)—

1 (A) in the subparagraph heading, by in-
2 serting “AND MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF
3 REPRESENTATIVES” after “SENATORS”;

4 (B) by inserting “or a Member of the
5 House of Representatives” after “who is a Sen-
6 ator”; and

7 (C) by inserting “or Member of the House
8 of Representatives” after “such former Sen-
9 ator”; and

10 (2) in subparagraph (B)—

11 (A) in the subparagraph heading, by strik-
12 ing “MEMBERS AND OFFICERS” and inserting
13 “OFFICERS”;

14 (B) in clause (i)—

15 (i) by striking “Any person who is a
16 Member of the House of Representatives
17 or” and inserting “Any person who is”;

18 (ii) by striking “or (iii)”; and

19 (iii) by striking “such former Member
20 of Congress or” and inserting “such
21 former”;

22 (C) by striking clause (ii); and

23 (D) by redesignating clause (iii) as clause
24 (ii).

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 subsection (a) shall apply to individuals who leave office
3 on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
