A BILL

To require the Comptroller General of the United States to carry out a study of the National Credit Union Administration, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “NCUA Budget Trans-
5 parency Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. GAO STUDY.**

7 (a) STUDY.—The Comptroller General of the United
8 States shall carry out a study of the National Credit
9 Union Administration (“NCUA”) to—

1 (1) study the process and procedures related to
2 the budgeting practices of the NCUA;

3 (2) identify areas where the NCUA can provide
4 greater budget transparency to Members of Con-
5 gress, the NCUA's regulated entities, and the public;
6 and

7 (3) determine the availability of line-by-line
8 budget data for the National Credit Union Share In-
9 surance Fund, the National Credit Union Central
10 Liquidity Facility, and the Temporary Corporate
11 Credit Union Stabilization Fund.

12 (b) REPORT.—Not later than the end of the 18-
13 month period beginning on the date of the enactment of
14 this Act, the Comptroller General shall issue a report to
15 the Congress containing all findings and determinations
16 made in carrying out the study required under subsection
17 (a).

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
