Mr. RANGEL introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on Armed Services and Rules, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To require that overseas contingency operations be paid for.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT THAT OVERSEAS CONTINGENCY**

4 **OPERATIONS BE PAID FOR.**

5 (a) AMOUNTS APPROPRIATED FOR FISCAL YEAR
6 2015.—No amount otherwise made available for Overseas
7 Contingency Operations for fiscal year 2015 may be obli-
8 gated during the period beginning on the date which is
9 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act and
10 ending on the date of the enactment of a law which in-

1 cludes provisions which increase revenues by not less than
2 the aggregate amount appropriated for Overseas Contingency
3 Operations for fiscal year 2015. A provision to increase
4 revenue shall not be taken into account under the
5 preceding sentence unless the law which includes such provision
6 includes a statement that specifically indicates that
7 such provision is to be taken into account for purposes
8 of satisfying the requirement of this subsection.

9 (b) POINT OF ORDER REGARDING INCREASED FUNDING FOR OVERSEAS CONTINGENCY OPERATIONS.—Rule
10 XXI of the Rules of the House of Representatives is
11 amended by adding at the end the following new clause:
12

13 “12. It shall not be in order to consider a bill or joint
14 resolution, or an amendment thereto or conference report
15 thereon, if the provisions of such measure increase
16 amounts made available for Overseas Contingency Operations
17 for any fiscal year, unless such measure includes
18 provisions which increase revenues by not less than the
19 increase in Overseas Contingency Operations for that fiscal
20 year.”.
