A BILL

To extend the final planting date for grain sorghum under Federal crop insurance policies because of extreme weather conditions that have adversely affected field conditions for planting, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Farmer Flexibility
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. WEATHER-RELATED EXTENSION OF FINAL PLANT-**
2 **ING DATE FOR GRAIN SORGHUM UNDER FED-**
3 **ERAL CROP INSURANCE POLICIES.**

4 (a) EXTENSION.—In recognition of the extreme
5 weather conditions that have adversely affected field con-
6 ditions for planting grain sorghum, the final planting date
7 established by the Risk Management Agency for any Fed-
8 eral crop insurance policy covering grain sorghum with a
9 current final planting date of April 5, 2015, is hereby ex-
10 tended to April 26, 2015.

11 (b) INCLUSION IN CONTRACTS.—The extension of the
12 final planting date provided by subsection (a) applies to
13 all contracts for a Federal crop insurance policy covering
14 grain sorghum with a current final planting date of April
15 5, 2015, whether entered into before, on, or after the date
16 of the enactment of this Act.

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
