A BILL

To amend the Veterans Access, Choice, and Accountability Act of 2014 to improve the private treatment of veterans who are victims of military sexual assault.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Military Sexual Assault
5 Victims Empowerment Act” or the “Military SAVE Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. IMPROVEMENT OF TREATMENT FOR MILITARY SEX-**
2 **UAL ASSAULT AT NON-DEPARTMENT FACILI-**
3 **TIES.**

4 Subsection (b) of section 101 of the Veterans Access,
5 Choice, and Accountability Act of 2014 (Public Law 113–
6 146; 38 U.S.C. 1701 note) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1)(A), by inserting “except as
8 provided by paragraph (2)(E),” before “as of”; and

9 (2) in paragraph (2)—

10 (A) in subparagraph (C)(ii), by striking
11 “or”;

12 (B) in subparagraph (D)(ii)(II), by strik-
13 ing the period at the end and inserting “; or”;
14 and

15 (C) by adding at the end the following new
16 subparagraph:

17 “(E) is a victim of a military sexual trau-
18 ma described in section 1720D(a)(1) of title 38,
19 United States Code, regardless of the date on
20 which the veteran enrolls in the patient enroll-
21 ment system of the Department of Veterans Af-
22 fairs established and operated under section
23 1705 of such title.”.

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
