3 **SECTION 1. REMOVING LIMITATION.**

4 Section 103(cc)(2)(E) of the Truth in Lending Act
5 (as added by section 1401 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street
6 Reform and Consumer Protection Act) is amended—

7 (1) by striking clause (ii); and

- 1 (2) by redesignating clauses (iii), (iv), and (v)
- 2 as clauses (ii), (iii), and (iv), respectively.

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
