Mr. LAMBORN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

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## A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Interior to establish the Ronald Reagan Birthplace National Historic Site in Tampico, Illinois, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Ronald Reagan Birth-

5       place Historic Site Establishment Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. RONALD REAGAN BIRTHPLACE HISTORIC SITE.**

7       (a) ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY.—As soon as prac-

8       ticable after the date of enactment of this Act, the Sec-

9       retary shall purchase with donated or appropriated funds

10      and from a willing owner only, fee simple, unencumbered

1 title to the Property and to any personal property related  
2 to the Property that the Secretary determines to be appro-  
3 priate for the purposes of this Act.

4 (b) ESTABLISHMENT.—After the Property is ac-  
5 quired by the Secretary, the Secretary shall designate the  
6 Property as the Ronald Reagan Birthplace Historic Site.

7 (c) LAND DESCRIPTION.—The Secretary shall ensure  
8 that a copy of the land description of the Property is on  
9 file and available for public inspection in the appropriate  
10 offices of the National Park Service.

11 **SEC. 3. ADMINISTRATION.**

12 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall administer  
13 the Historic Site in accordance with the provisions of this  
14 Act and with laws generally applicable to national historic  
15 sites, including—

16 (1) applicable provisions of division A of sub-  
17 title I of title 54, United States Code; and

18 (2) chapter 3201 of title 54, United States  
19 Code.

20 (b) SHARED RESOURCES.—To the greatest extent  
21 practicable, the Secretary shall use the resources of other  
22 sites administered by the National Park Service in the  
23 State of Illinois.

1 (c) MANAGEMENT PLAN.—Not later than 2 years  
2 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall  
3 prepare a general management plan for the Historic Site.

4 **SEC. 4. DEFINITIONS.**

5 In this Act:

6 (1) HISTORIC SITE.—The term “Historic Site”  
7 means the Ronald Reagan Birthplace National His-  
8 toric Site.

9 (2) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means  
10 the Secretary of the Interior.

11 (3) PROPERTY.—The term “Property” means  
12 the property commonly known as the Reagan Birth-  
13 place and Museum located at—

14 (A) 111–113 Main Street, Tampico, Illi-  
15 nois; and

16 (B) the Main Street Historic District  
17 which was added to the National Register of  
18 Historic Places on June 3, 1983 (Ref. #  
19 82002602).

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
