A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to prohibit an institution of higher education located in the United States from participating in student assistance programs under title IV of such Act if the institution bans the display of the flag of the United States on its campus.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Federal Funds
5 Without the American Flag Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING PARTICIPATION IN FEDERAL ASSIST-**
2 **ANCE PROGRAMS BY INSTITUTIONS OF HIGH-**
3 **ER EDUCATION BANNING DISPLAY OF FLAG**
4 **OF UNITED STATES ON CAMPUS.**

5 Section 487(a) of the Higher Education Act of 1965
6 (20 U.S.C. 1094(a)) is amended by adding at the end the
7 following new paragraph:

8 “(30) The institution will not ban the display of
9 the flag of the United States on its campus, except
10 that this paragraph does not apply to an institution
11 described in section 102(a)(1)(C).”.

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
