1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TARIFF PREFERENCE LEVEL**
2 **ON IMPORTS OF CERTAIN COTTON AND MAN-**
3 **MADE FIBER, FABRIC, APPAREL, AND MADE-**
4 **UP GOODS FROM BAHRAIN UNDER THE**
5 **UNITED STATES-BAHRAIN FREE TRADE**
6 **AGREEMENT.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—U.S. Note 13 to subchapter XIV
8 of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
9 United States is amended—

10 (1) in the matter preceding paragraph (a)—

11 (A) by striking “2015” and inserting
12 “2025”; and

13 (B) by striking “January 1, 2016, through
14 July 31, 2016” and inserting “January 1,
15 2026, through July 31, 2026”; and

16 (2) in the matter following paragraph (d), by
17 striking “July 31, 2016” and inserting “July 31,
18 2026”.

19 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
20 this section shall apply with respect to articles entered,
21 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
22 January 1, 2016.

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
