A BILL

To amend the Equal Credit Opportunity Act to repeal a small business loan data collection requirement.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Right to Lend Act
5 of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. SMALL BUSINESS LOAN DATA COLLECTION RE-**
7 **QUIREMENT.**

8 (a) REPEAL.—Section 704B of the Equal Credit Op-
9 portunity Act (15 U.S.C. 1691c–2) is repealed.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section 701(b) of
2 the Equal Credit Opportunity Act (15 U.S.C. 1691(b)) is
3 amended—

4 (1) in paragraph (3), by inserting “or” at the
5 end;

6 (2) in paragraph (4), by striking “; or” and in-
7 serting a period; and

8 (3) by striking paragraph (5).

9 (c) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
10 for title VII of the Consumer Credit Protection Act is
11 amended by striking the item relating to section 704B.

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
