A BILL

To authorize the extension of preferential tariff treatment for certain textile goods imported from Morocco.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TARIFF PREFERENCE LEVEL**

4 **PROGRAM FOR MOROCCO.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—U.S. Note 64(b) to subchapter
6 XII of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of
7 the United States is amended—

8 (1) by striking “shall be as follows:” and all
9 that follows through “As used in this note” and in-
10 serting “shall be 10,000,000 SME for each of the

1 calendar years 2016 through 2025. As used in this
2 note”; and

3 (2) by striking “December 31, 2015” and in-
4 serting “December 31, 2025”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
6 this section shall apply with respect to articles entered,
7 or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
8 January 1, 2016.

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
