Mr. SAM JOHNSON of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred
to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To terminate certain toll authorities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No More Tolls for
5 Roads Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF CERTAIN TOLL AUTHORITIES.**

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, on and
8 after January 1, 2016—

9 (1) Federal participation in an activity that re-
10 sults in the construction of a new toll facility, or the
11 conversion of a toll-free facility to a toll facility,

1 under section 129(a) of title 23, United States Code,
2 is prohibited;

3 (2) a toll may not be charged pursuant to sec-
4 tion 166 of title 23, United States Code, with re-
5 spect to any facility, or segment thereof, if the toll
6 was not established with respect to that facility or
7 segment before January 1, 2016; and

8 (3) the Secretary of Transportation may not,
9 under any pilot or demonstration program, carry out
10 an activity that results in the establishment of a toll
11 with respect to a highway, or segment thereof, if the
12 toll was not established with respect to that highway
13 or segment before January 1, 2016.

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
